

The Labor Market **Decline** Over the Past 15 Years in Ohio

The labor participation rate—the share of the population in the labor force-has dropped significantly across the U.S. since the recession. Ohio, which finished 2013 ranked No. 31, has faced a similar decline in its labor force participation rate.
