


## **WORKER FREEDOM JOB PERFORMANCE.** Percentage change in jobs since 1990




#### **OHIO PRIVATE-SECTOR EMPLOYMENT.**

### JOB GROWTH IN OHIO BY GOVERNOR TERM. Year-to-year (December to December) change in jobs, in thousands


