










# JOB GROWTH IN OHIO BY GOVERNOR TERM. Year-to-year (December to December) change in jobs, in thousands

Oklahoma, Indiana, and Michigan became Right-to-Work states in 2001, 2012, and 2013, respectively. Wisconsin is categorized as Forced Unionization but became Right-to-Work in March 2015.
