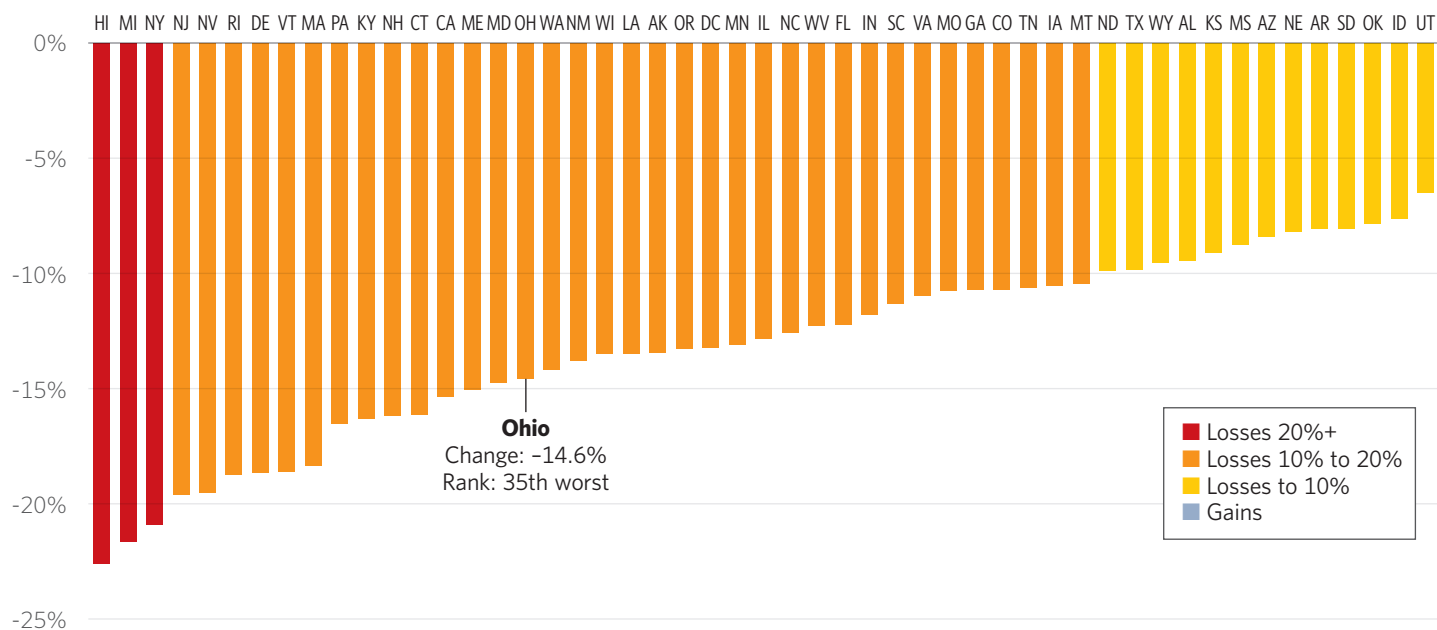

CHANGE IN JOBS, FEBRUARY 2020–MAY 2020

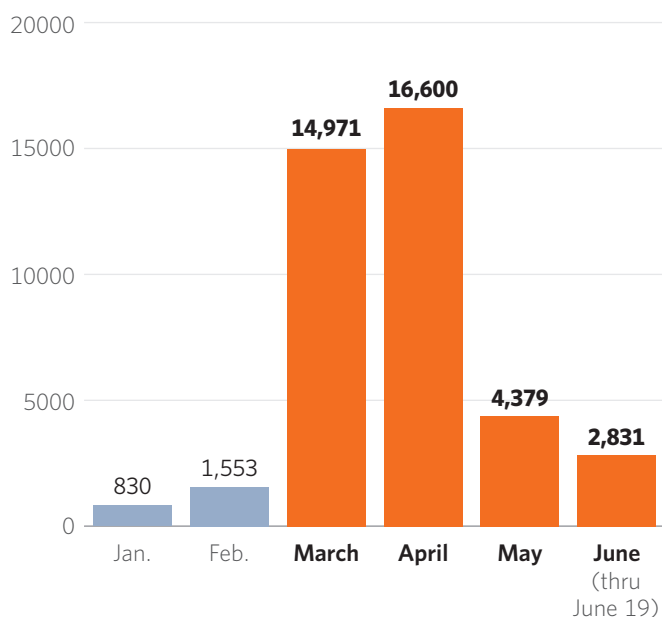

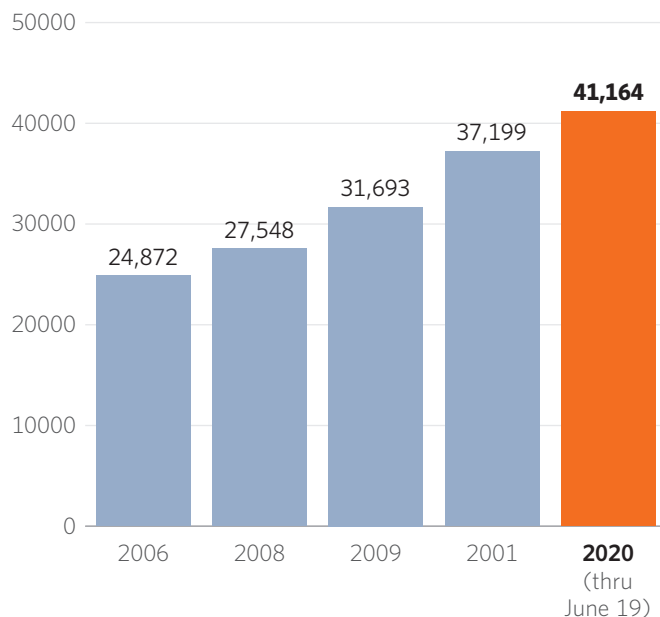


Mass Layoff Have Surged in Ohio Due to Virus

FIVE HIGHEST YEARS FOR MASS LAYOFFS SINCE 1997



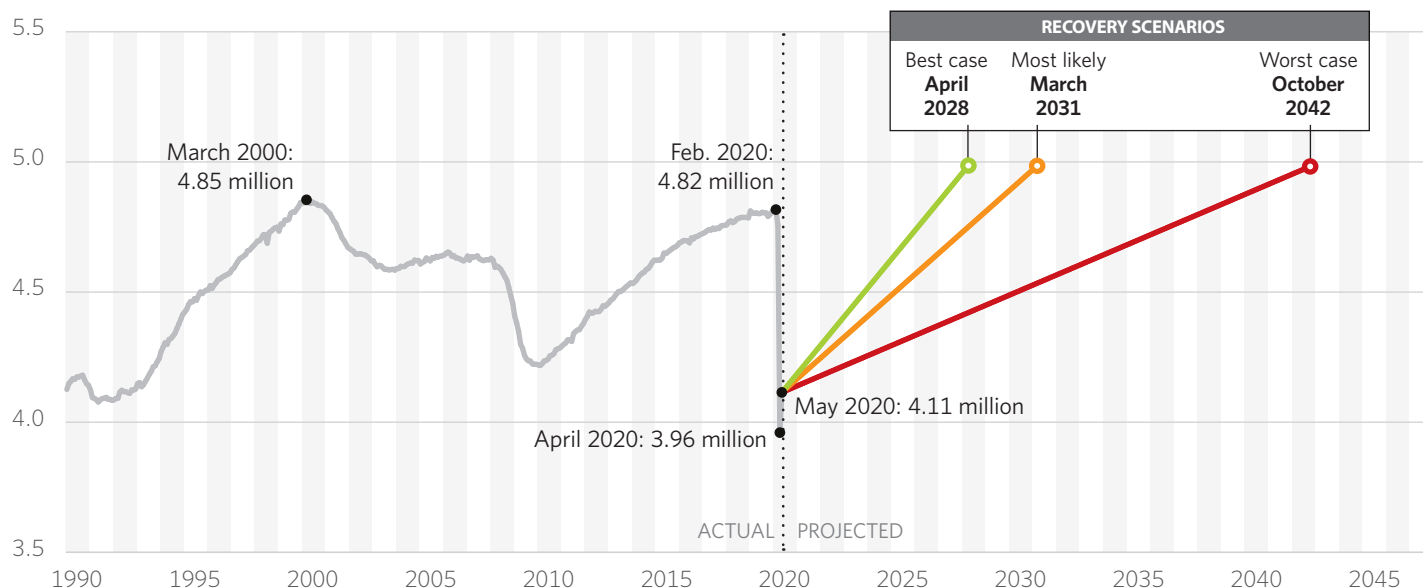

OHIO PRIVATE-SECTOR EMPLOYMENT, IN MILLIONS



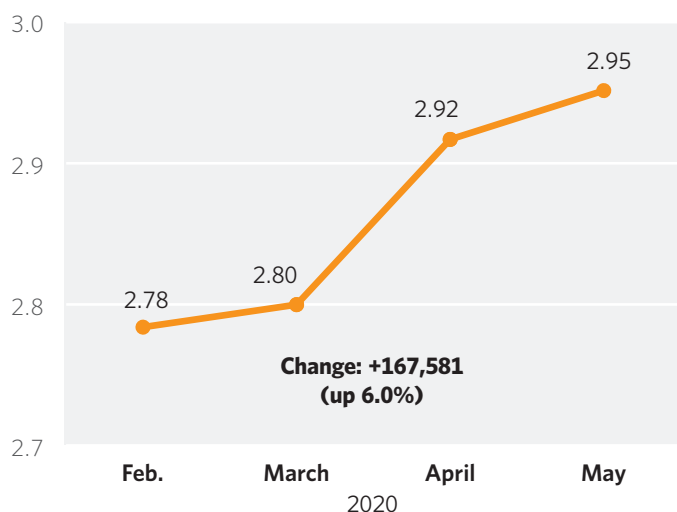

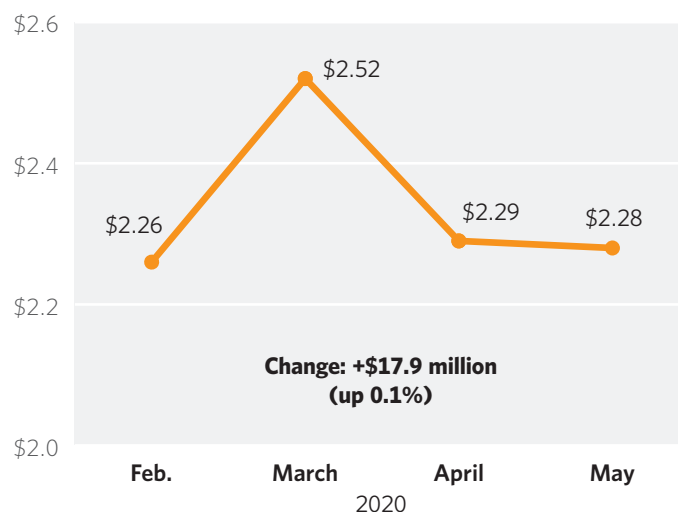


Changes to Ohio Medicaid

COSTS, IN BILLIONS

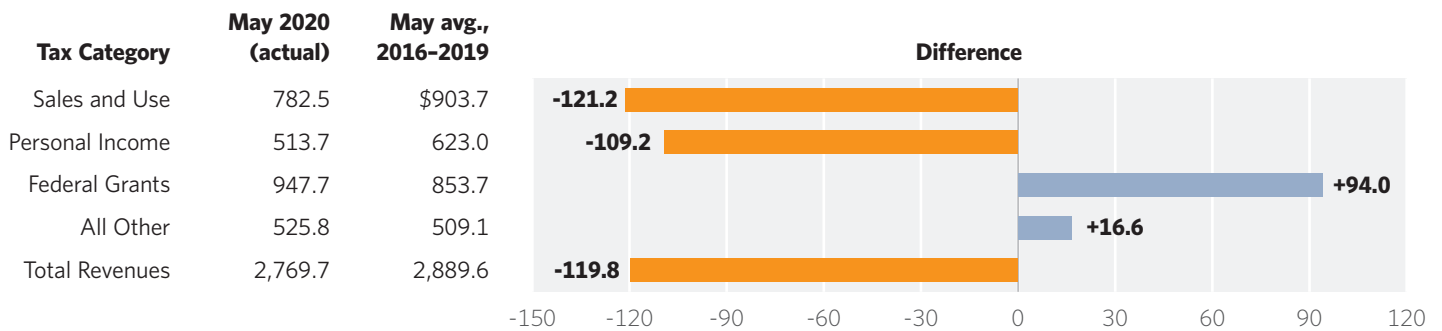

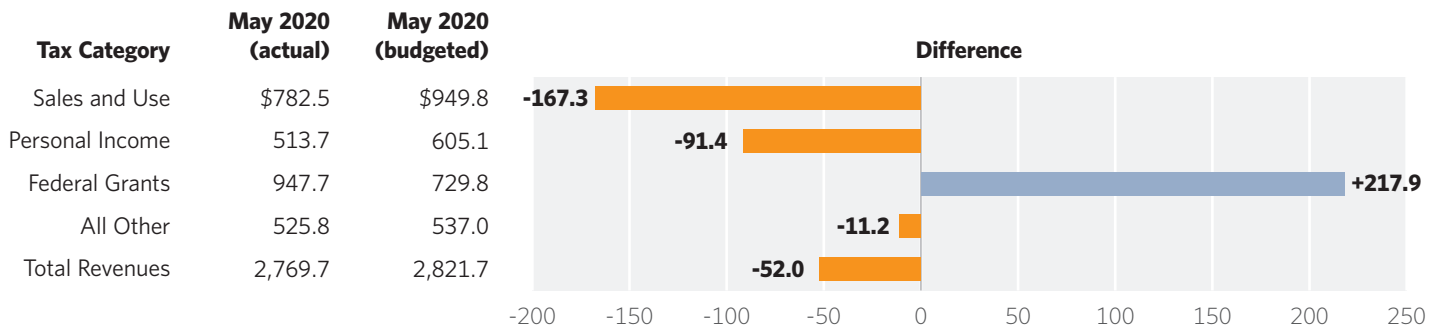

State Tax Revenues: May 2020 actual vs. budgeted estimate

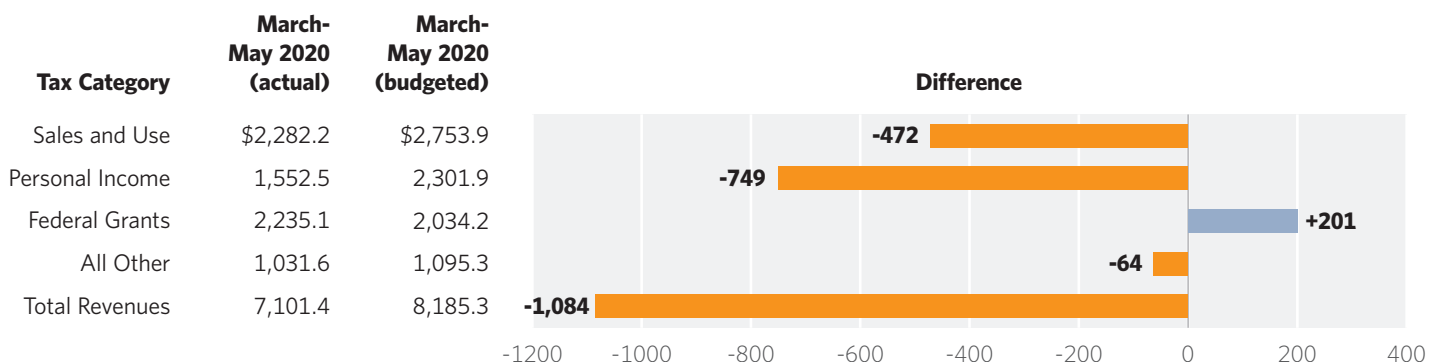
