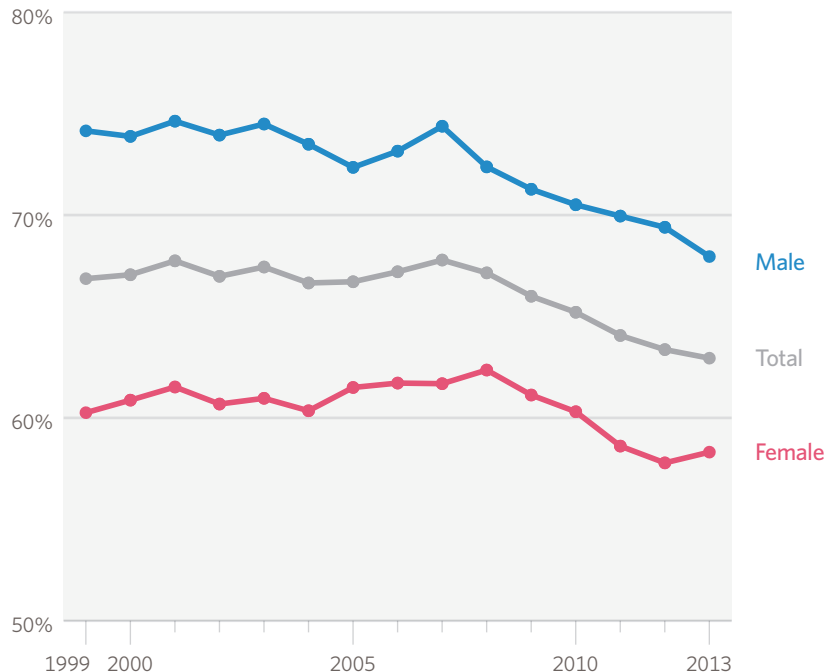


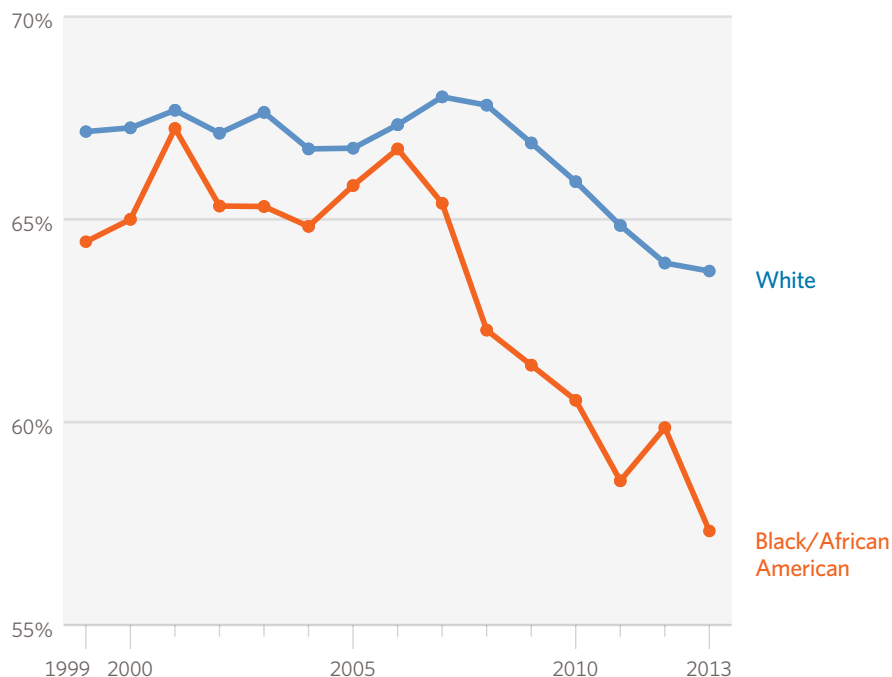
# The Labor Market Decline Over the Past 15 Years in Ohio

The labor participation rate—the share of the population in the labor force—has dropped significantly across the U.S. since the recession. Ohio, which finished 2013 ranked **No. 31**, has faced a similar decline in its labor force participation rate.
