



Ohio Republican Presidential Primary Survey Topline Results

Magellan Strategies is pleased to present the topline results for a 759n autodial and cell phone survey of likely 2016 Republican Presidential primary voters in the state of Ohio. The interviews were conducted March 9th – 10th, 2016. This survey has a margin of error of +/- 3.56% at the 95 percent confidence interval. This survey was weighted based upon past primary election voting demographics.

Survey Methodology

This survey was conducted using automated telephone touchtone technology and live interviews of cell phones only households. The sample used for this survey was randomly drawn from a statewide Ohio voter file. The survey response data was weighted based upon voter turnout demographics of past Republican primary elections in Ohio. The interviews were conducted on March 9^{th} – 10^{th} , 2016. Three attempts were made to interview each household in the sample. This survey has a margin of error of 3.56% at the 95 percent confidence interval.
