



Ohio in Rare Company with Negative Jobs Recovery

Ohio's private-sector employment peaked in March 2000 at 4.85 million jobs. As of August 2016, that figure was 4.72 million, leaving Ohio (down 2.8 percent) as one of only four states that has failed to fully recover the jobs lost since March 2000.
