

Mitigating the threat of domestic terrorism requires strengthening connectivity and trust between America's Muslim communities and local law enforcement. One way to achieve this would be to fund the creation of Regional Outreach Groups (ROGs) in major urban areas already identified to be at high risk of terrorist attacks. These ROGs would function as meeting spaces between stakeholders in both local law enforcement and Muslim communities, building trust and connectivity.
