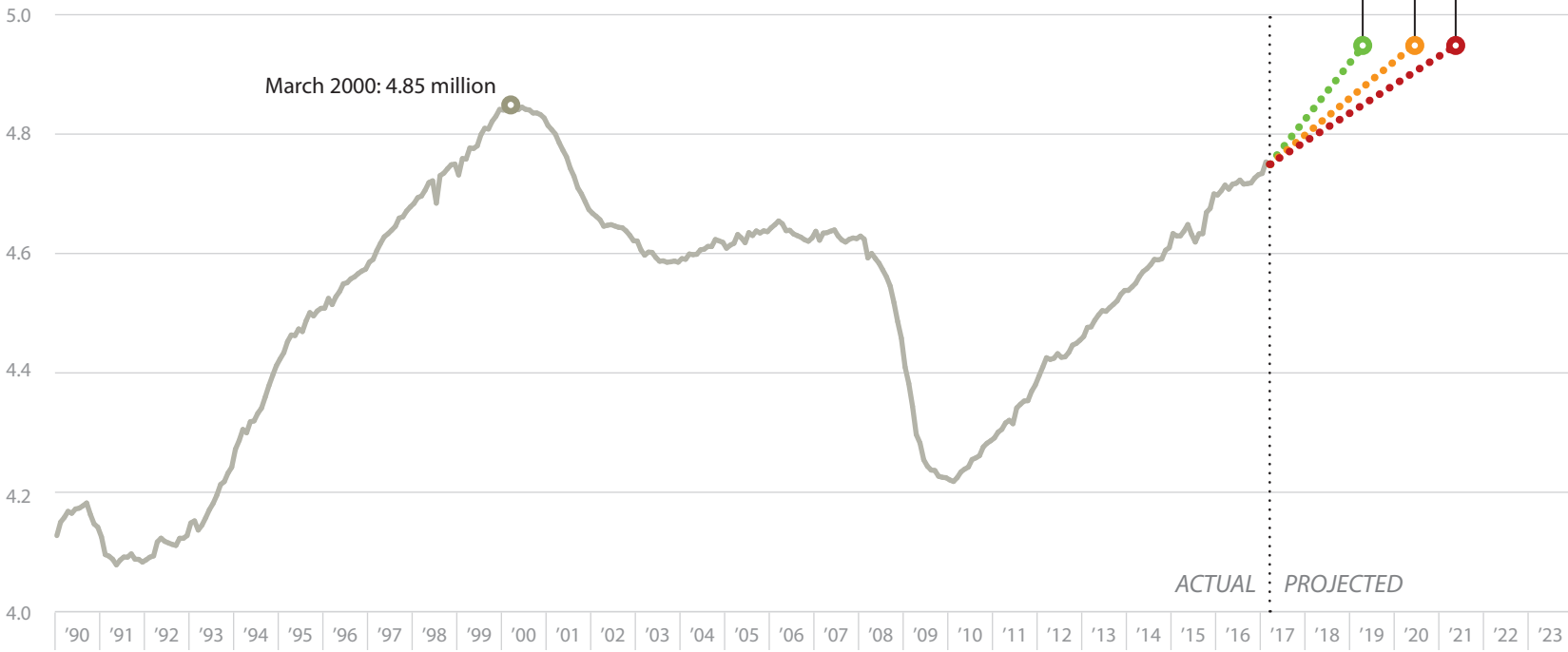


WHEN WILL OHIO FULLY RECOVER?
