Big Cities Grow as Rest of State Shrinks

Of the 25 counties in Ohio seeing a growth in population from 2010 to 2016, all but 10 are part of large metropolitan cities. The remaining 63 counties lost more than 123,000 citizens in just six years. Without the growth in Franklin County—where federal, state, county, and city governments reside, as well as The Ohio State University—Ohio would have lost nearly 25,000 citizens.
