

Ohio's Recovery Hindered by Mass Layoffs

While job opportunities in Ohio have increased, there are signs the state may not be making the most of the strong national economy. Jobs lost in the state from mass layoffs have spiked. There were **14,079 such layoffs in 2018**, the highest year-to-date total since the Great Recession, and the trend appears to be continuing in 2019 with a higher-than-average 1,763 layoffs.

Mass Layoffs Surging in Ohio




Monthly Mass Layoffs in Ohio
