
Ohio's Recovery Hindered by Mass Layoffs


While job opportunities in Ohio have increased, there are signs the state may not be making the most of the strong national economy. Jobs lost in the state from mass layoffs spiked last year—there were **14,079 such layoffs in 2018**, the highest year-to-date total since the Great Recession. In 2019, there have been **5,249** layoffs through May.
