


Ohio Jobs Have Flatlined While Medicaid Soars

After John Kasich irresponsibly expanded Medicaid in 2013, nearly 1 million Ohioans have been added to the program. Medicaid spending skyrocketed from \$17.3 billion in fiscal year 2012–2013 to \$29.3 billion in fiscal year 2020–2021, totaling \$57.1 billion in new spending. Though Ohio clawed back 116,500 private sector jobs in 2021, its private sector is only 136,600 larger today than it was in 2013. Shockingly, Medicaid is now 72 percent the size of Ohio’s entire private sector.
