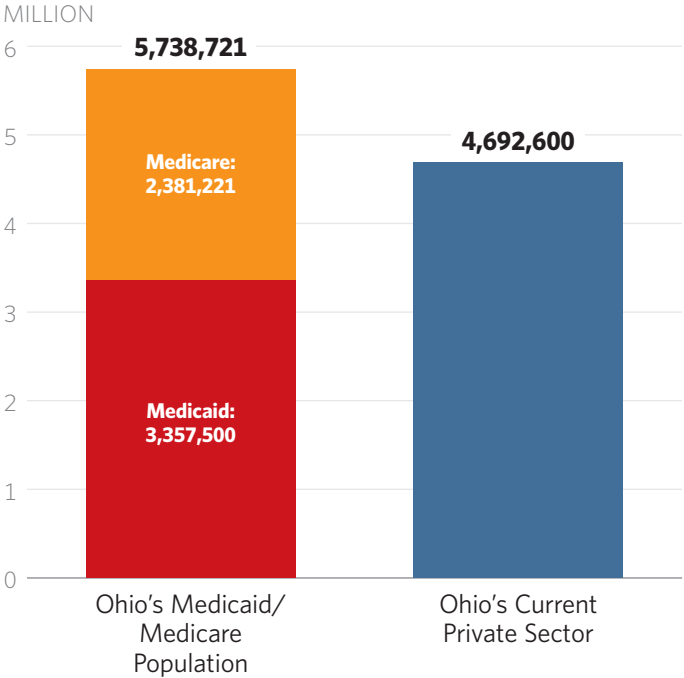


More Beneficiaries than Workers

In Ohio, 5.7 million people receive either Medicaid or Medicare. That's **1.05 million people more** than the state's total number of private-sector jobs and creates an increasingly unbalanced tax burden, with beneficiaries growing at a faster pace than jobs.
