


Changes in Employment by Metropolitan Statistical Area, 2000-2022


Changes in Employment by Metropolitan Statistical Area, JobsOhio Era



Akron MSA Employment Since 2000






Canton MSA Employment Since 2000








Cincinnati MSA Employment Since 2000








Columbus MSA Employment Since 2000







Dayton MSA Employment Since 2000








Lima MSA Employment Since 2000







Mansfield MSA Employment Since 2000








Springfield MSA Employment Since 2000







Steubenville MSA Employment Since 2000








Toledo MSA Employment Since 2000
