
WARN Act Layoffs


The Wuhan Virus has had a devastating impact on employment in Ohio. There were 55,305 jobs lost to mass layoffs in 2020, making it the single-worst year for mass layoffs since 1997. There were far fewer mass layoffs in 2021 (2,216) and 2022 (7,707).
