
WARN Act Layoffs

The Wuhan Virus has had a devastating impact on employment in Ohio. There were **55,305 jobs lost** to mass layoffs in 2020, making it the single-worst year for mass layoffs since 1997. There were far fewer mass layoffs in 2021 (2,216) and 2022 (7,707).

Wuhan Virus Caused Record Mass Layoffs in Ohio


MONTHLY MASS LAYOFF NOTICES SINCE 1997
