
WARN Act Layoffs


The Wuhan Virus has had a devastating impact on employment in Ohio. There were 55,305 jobs lost to mass layoffs in 2020, making it the single-worst year for mass layoffs since 1997. In fact, 2020 had three times as many mass layoffs as the total for 2021–2023.
